Programs and Services Priorities

Council confirmed the Programs and Services Priorities as presented, with the addition of the Economic Development priorities.

A workshop will be held in the near future, with a face to face meeting if possible, to discuss the preparation of the operating (3 years) and capital (5 years) budgets.

Strategic Plan Review

Council approved the revised 2018-2022 Strategic Plan.

FFCS Requests for Funding

Flagstaff County will work collaboratively with the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee (BREOC) and Flagstaff Family and Community Services (FFCS) to discuss Covid-19 strategies and long-term strategies around Social Resiliency.

Expansion of Level 1 Peace Officer Authorities on Primary Highways

A formal letter will be submitted to the Peace Officer Program requesting an exemption from Section 24.15 of the Peace Officer Program Policy and Procedures Manual, to authorize the Flagstaff County Peace Officers to conduct traffic enforcement on one and two digit highways, within their jurisdiction, regardless of the speed limit.

Oiled Roads

Council defeated the following motions:

1. To cancel the transitioning of the oiled road 103.
2. That all oiled roads be transitioned back to gravel as they deteriorate, at the discretion of Public Works.
