Regional Governance Project—ACP Grant Report

The request for approval of the Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership Final Report for the Regional Governance Project, and not proceed with the proposed regional amalgamation was deferred to the next Council Meeting for further information.

Asset Management Plan—FCM Grant

Council directed administration to apply for a grant opportunity from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Municipal Asset Management Program for “Levels of Service and Risk Assessment for Water, Sanitary and Transportation Services”. That Flagstaff County commits to conducting the following activities in its proposed project submitted to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Municipal Asset Management Program to advance our asset management program:

- Levels of Service Assessment for water, sanitary and transportation
- Risk Assessment
- Documentation

Flagstaff County has committed \$50,000 from its 2020 budget towards the cost of this initiative.

Valley Ski Hill Guarantor Dissolution Agreement

Flagstaff County will not partner with the County of Paintearth to offer guarantor’s letter to the landowner stating that in the event of the Valley Ski Hill ceasing operations that both Counties would be responsible for reclaiming the leased lands.

Emergency Services Committee

The following resolution was rescinded: Resolution FC20200408.1012, THAT due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Flagstaff County defer any decision on the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society, until the federal and provincial governments declare the pandemic over.

Council approved the outstanding invoices received from Reynolds Mirth Richards & Farmer (RMRF) for the preparation and legal consultation costs totaling \$19,929.08, that were over the ACP grant budgeted, be paid based on the proposed allocation costs in the FRESS Business and Implementation Plan requisition allocation, as follows:

- Flagstaff County (63.58%) - \$12,670.91
- Killam (7.42%) - \$1,478.74
- Sedgewick (6.61%) - \$1,317.31
- Forestburg (6.24%) - \$1,243.57
- Hardisty (6.08%) - \$1,211.69
- Daysland (6.06%) - \$1,207.70
- Lougheed (1.77%) - \$352.74
- Alliance (1.18%) - \$235.16
- Heisler (1.07%) - \$213.24
