**ACCOUNTABILITY TO VISION STATEMENT**

Quality of life and economic prosperity are enhanced through the safe movement of people, goods and services.

**POLICY STATEMENT**

In order to ensure the safety of the public and manage risk, Flagstaff County will have consistent design and placement standards for approaches.

Each quarter section of land will be provided one approach, at no cost, where there is no existing approach. If additional approaches are approved by Flagstaff County, the landowner is responsible for the costs of the construction of each such additional approach.

The Public Works department is authorized to undertake for construction of approaches on private property, providing such service is at the request of landowners.

The level, timing and condition of the construction of approaches services are subject to the limitations inherent to:

- the limited availability of human resources and equipment;
- the constant changing nature of weather;
- the provision of services on an economically practical and feasible basis.

Approach access for resource or commercial purposes is not the financial responsibility of the County.
