




Order Number 2020-5

Defining Maximum Allowable Weights Permitted on Certain Municipal Roads

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Minister of Infrastructure under the Traffic Safety Act and Bylaw 02/06; **Flagstaff County orders that effective 0700 hrs, Tuesday, December 1, 2020**; permitted weights for roads located within Flagstaff County are as follows:

Location	Restriction
A.) The following Oil Surface Roads in the County are banned at 90%	90%
1) Range Road 151, North for 0.4 miles from Highway 13	90%
2) Township Road 425A, Southwest for 1.75 miles from Highway 13	90%
3) Range Road 103, South for 1 mile from Township Road 425	90%
4) Township Road 442, East for 2 miles from Range Road 130	90%
5) Range Road 130, North for 0.2 miles from Highway 13	90%
6) Range Road 131, North for 0.75 miles from Highway 13	100%
7) Township Road 442, East for 0.4375 miles from Secondary Highway 869	100%
B.) All Arterial/Collector/Local Roads in the County are not banned, except:	100%
1) Range Road 125, North for 0.75 miles from Township Road 414	75%
2) Township Road 432, East for 2 miles from Range Road 142	75%
3) Range Road 110, South for 2 miles from Township Road 460	75%
4) Range Road 145, South for 1.75 miles from Township Road 452	75%
5) Range Road 145, North for 1.5 miles from Township Road 454	75%
6) Range Road 122, South for 2 miles from Township Road 420	75%
7) Range Road 120, South for 1.5 miles from Township Road 412	75%
8) Range Road 100, South for 6 miles from Township Road 420	75%
9) Township Road 414, East for 2 miles from Range Road 154	75%
10) Township Road 454, East for 3 miles from Range Road 170	75%
11) Range Road 164, South for 1.75 miles from Township Road 454	75%
12) Township Road 422, East for 2 miles from Range Road 140	75%
13) Township Road 424, East for 3 miles from Secondary Highway 869	75%
