Defining Maximum Allowable Weights Permitted on Certain Municipal Roads

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Minister of Infrastructure under the Traffic Safety Act and Bylaw 02/22; **Flagstaff County orders that effective 0700 hrs, Monday, August 29, 2022;** permitted weights for roads located within Flagstaff County are as follows:

| 1) Range Road 151, North from Highway 13 for 0.4 miles | 75% |
| 2) Township Road 425A, Southwest from Highway 13 for 1.75 miles | 75% |
| 3) Range Road 103, South from Township Road 425 for 1 mile | 75% |
| 4) Township Road 442, East from Range Road 130 for 2.0 miles | 75% |
| 5) Range Road 130, North from Highway 13 for 0.2 miles | 75% |
| 6) Range Road 131, North from Highway 13 for 0.75 miles | 100% |
| 7) Township Road 442, East from Secondary Highway 869 for 0.4375 miles | 100% |
| B.) All Arterial/Collector/Local Roads in the County are not banned, except: | |

| 1) Range Road 125, North for 0.75 miles from Township Road 414 | 75% |
| 2) Township Road 432, East for 2 miles from Range Road 142 | 75% |
| 3) Range Road 120, South for 1.5 miles from Township Road 412 | 75% |
| 4) Range Road 100, South for 6 miles from Township Road 420 | 75% |
| 5) Township Road 414, West for 2 miles from Range Road 124 | 75% |
| 6) Township Road 454, East for 3 miles from Range Road 170 | 75% |
| 7) Range Road 164, South for 1.75 miles from Township Road 454 | 75% |
| 8) Township Road 422, East for 3 miles from Range Road 141 | 75% |
