Highway 13:16 & 881:02 Construction

Project Details

Alberta Transportation will be changing the configuration of the access points into Hardisty. Improvements that will be most noticeable to drivers will be the upgrading of the existing Hwy 13/881 intersection, the closure of the north leg of Range Road 100A, and the construction of a new intersection at Hwy 13 and 48 Street.

Construction will be completed in conjunction with a paving project on Highways 13 and 881 in 2017. Paving will occur on Hwy 13 between Hardisty and Amisk, and on Hwy 881 between Hwy 13 and 48 Avenue. Other works as part of this project include new overhead illumination installed on Hwy 881 between Hwy 13 and 48 Ave as well as the construction of a eastbound climbing lane between the Battle River and the Tank Farm.

Schedule

The expected Schedule is as follows, but is subject to change without notice:

Grading work	July - August 2017
Paving	August 2017
Contract Completion	October 2017

What to Expect

Construction is expected to take place over the Summer of 2017. As with any construction project, travelers may experience speed reductions, lane closures, detours and potential delays. Motorists can check for updated traffic and construction information at 511.Alberta.ca or by calling **5-1-1**

Nearby residents may experience a temporary increase of construction related noise and traffic in the area, including large equipment. Intermittent odors associated with paving can also be expected.

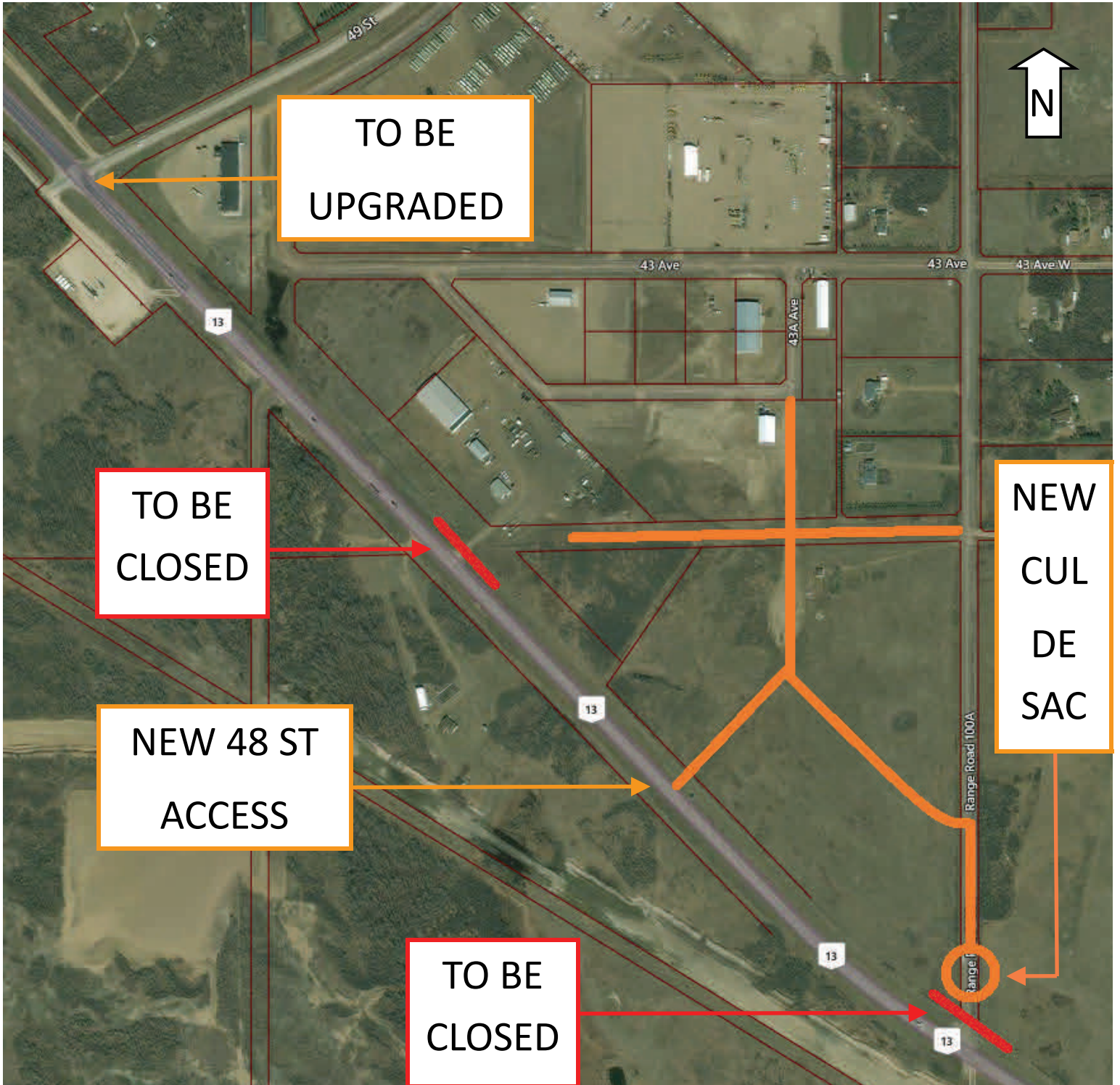


Figure 1 Planned revisions to Highway 13 access to Hardisty
