## Regional Services:

**Regional Emergency Services Coordinator:** Assists the towns and villages in training, equipment coordination and fire prevention and investigation.

**Economic Development:** Provides programs and services to the citizens and businesses of the region focusing on sustainability and community development.

**Fire:** Owns 50% of eight fire trucks in eight towns and villages, owns five Wildland trucks for fire suppression use at a cost of \$117,878 each, owns a water tanker for the region at \$201,635, contributed \$219,419 towards operating expenses for town and village fire departments.

**Rescue:** Contributed 58%, \$12,354, of the operating costs for rescue services.
