

## Regular Council Meeting of May 24, 2023

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

**Crushing Tender Results – Mazure Pit** 

Council accepted the bid received for the Crushing and Stockpiling of Gravel (CR-02-2023) from McNabb Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$385,600 plus fuel adjustment if required, funding any additional costs from Reserves – Gravel.

**Crushing Tender Results – Northeast Area** 

Council accepted the bid received for the Supply, Crush, and Stockpiling of Gravel (CR-01-2023) for the Northeast Area of the County, from McDonald Aggregates Inc., in the amount of \$812,500 plus GST.

**SDAB and ARB Member Appointment** 

Council appointed Murray Hampshire as a member on the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board and the Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board, each for an additional three-year term.

Agricultural Service Board – New Member-At-Large

Council appointed Cole McMahon as a member-at-large to the Agricultural Service Board for a three-year term.

**Diplomat Mine Museum Society – Request for Park Maintenance** 

Council approved the request to provide general park maintenance services to the Diplomat Mine Museum Society, and increase the 2023 Parks operating budget by \$22,000. The Diplomat Mine Interpretive Site was previously maintained by Alberta Parks.

Township Road 452

Council confirmed to proceed with the road recovery project for NNW 10-45-16-W4 Township Road 452, as approved in the 2023 budget. A resident had appeared before Council and requested that councillors reconsider the motion accepted to rip up the oil on Township Road 452 and rebuild and replace with gravel.

Results of 2024 Business Plan and Budget Public Participation Plan

Council accepted the feedback gained through the Business Plan and Budget Public Participation Plan and will further evaluate the feedback when reviewing the Programs and Services Priorities and in the development of the 2024 Business Plan and Budget.
