Defining Maximum Allowable Weights Permitted on Certain Municipal Roads

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Minister of Infrastructure under the Traffic Safety Act and Bylaw 07/23; Flagstaff County orders that effective 0700 hrs, Monday, April 15, 2024; permitted weights for roads located within Flagstaff County are as follows:

A.) The following Oil Surface Roads in the County are banned as follows: Range Road 151, North from Highway 13 for 0.4 miles	
Range Road 151, North from Highway 13 for 0.4 miles

Township Road 425A, Southwest from Highway 13 for 1.75 miles	50%
Range Road 103, South from Township Road 425 for 1 mile	50%
Township Road 442, East from Range Road 130 for 2 miles	50%
Range Road 130, North from Highway 13 for 0.2 miles	50%
Range Road 131, North from Highway 13 for 0.75 miles	100%
Township Road 442, East from Secondary Highway 869 for 0.4375 miles	100%
B.) All Arterial/Collector/Local & Field Access Roads in the County are not banned, except:	100%
Range Road 125, North for 0.75 miles from Township Road 414	75%
Township Road 432, East for 2 miles from Range Road 142	75%
Range Road 120, South for 1.5 miles from Township Road 412	75%
Range Road 100, South for 6 miles from Township Road 420	75%
Township Road 414, West for 2 miles from Range Road 124	75%
Township Road 454, East for 3 miles from Range Road 170	75%
Range Road 164, South for 1.75 miles from Township Road 454	75%
